SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska
Administrative Code (AAC):
17 AAC 25.220(d)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded this correction under a specific delegation dated March 23, 2020 from the regulations attorney. This revision corrects a manifest error.

The regulation to be revised is 17 AAC 25.220(d). The revision to that paragraph is as follows:

--Change "interstate" to "intrastate"

In addition, after 17 AAC 25.220 please insert an editor's note to read as follows:

Editor's note: As of Register 236 (January 2021), the regulations attorney made a technical revision under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to 17 AAC 25.220(d), to substitute the longstanding term "intrastate" for the accidental use of "interstate" when the Department of Law performed a technical reformatting of the regulations.

I have confirmed--from an examination of the regulations as they existed in previous versions of the Alaska Administrative Code, from the agency's original regulations as submitted to the Department of Law, from my reformatted version of the regulations, and from my communications with the agency--that the word "interstate" was accidentally introduced in the process of technical reformatting, and that the correct term in the regulations that took effect April 4, 2020 (Register 234) should be "intrastate".
