FINDING OF EMERGENCY

The State Medical Board finds that an emergency exists under AS 44.62.250, and that an emergency regulation change is necessary to 12 AAC 40.430, dealing with direct personal contact for physician assistant assessments, for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or general welfare. The facts constituting the emergency include the following:

The restrictive nature of these regulations could negatively impact the health of the public by decreasing healthcare worker availability, and putting healthcare workers' health under risk, during this public health emergency caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

ORDER CERTIFYING ADOPTION

I certify that the State Medical Board, under the authority of AS 08.64.100 and AS 08.64.107, adopted at its November 20, 2020 videoconference meeting the attached one page of regulation changes as an emergency regulation to take effect immediately upon filing by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180(3).

Chapter 40. State Medical Board.

12 AAC 40.430 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

12 AAC 40.430. Performance and assessment of practice.

(r) During an urgent situation as determined by the board, direct personal contact as required under this section may be met by audio and video or other electronic means; "urgent situation" has the meaning given in 12 AAC 40.045. On a motion duly made by Dr. Wein, seconded by Dr. Freeman, and approved by roll call vote the board adopted the emergency regulations for 12 AAC 40.430(r) to read, (r) During an urgent situation as determined by the board, direct personal contact as required under this section may include audio and video electronic means; "urgent situation" has the meaning given in 12 AAC 40.045(j).

Roll call vote: Yeas, Mr. Boswell, Dr. Daugherty, Dr. Freeman, Dr. Gay, Ms. Mielke, Dr. Wein Dr. Parker was not in attendance at the time of the vote.

The board decided to make the regulations permanent due to the definition of "urgent situation" in 12 AAC 40.045.
