The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Health and Social Services against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department of Health and Social Services after the close of the public comment period. The regulations update Medicaid coverage and payment provisions for vaccine products and vaccine administration, rearrange structure to improve readability, address the providers whose services are covered, particularly pharmacists, address the rates at which payments will be calculated, and expand the range of vaccine products and administration for which coverage and payment are available: in particular, vaccine products and administration related to a public health emergency or to protect against pandemic influenza strains like COVID-19.

The department requests these be filed as soon as possible.

The July 26, 2020 public notice and the December 10, 2020 adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.

 - o Adopt new professional payment methodology for vaccine administration by a pharmacist.
