The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Health and Social Services against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department of Health and Social Services after the close of the public comment period. The regulations provide for Medicaid coverage and payment for outpatient hospital observation services, not to exceed 48 hours, only if a recipient's condition warrants evaluation.

The September 3, 2020 public notice and the December 3, 2020 adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.
