

18 AAC 80.1990

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below.

--In 18 AAC 80.1990(109), the definition should be for the term "private water line" not "private water system." Please change to read: "private water line"

--In 18 AAC 80.1990, between paragraphs (130) and (132), there is currently a paragraph designated as "(31)." Please change this to read: "(131)"

--In addition, at the end of 18 AAC 80.1990, please add an editor's note as follows:

**Editor's note:** As of Register 237 (April 2021), and acting under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), the regulations attorney made technical changes to 18 AAC 80.1990 to correct manifest printing errors.

I have reviewed the amendment history for this regulation and confirmed that these were printing errors that occurred when 18 AAC 80.1990 was repealed and readopted in Register 230.
