SUBJECT: Correction to the Alaska
Administrative Code (AAC):
12 AAC 44.445(d)

In accordance with the authority of the regulations attorney under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the correction to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. I have forwarded this correction under a specific delegation dated March 23, 2020 from the regulations attorney. This revision is a conforming change to reflect the rearrangement of statutory subsections by the revisor of statutes under AS 01.05.031.

The regulation to be revised is 12 AAC 44.445(d). The revision to that subsection is as follows:

--Change "AS 17.30.200(o)" to "AS 17.30.200(n)"

In addition, in the editor's note following 12 AAC 44.445, please add a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:

In 2018 the revisor of statutes, acting under AS 01.05.031, rearranged the subsections in AS 17.30.200. As a result, the subsection formerly designated as AS 17.30.200(o) is now designated as AS 17.30.200(n). As of Register 237 (April 2020), the regulations attorney made a conforming technical revision under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to 12 AAC 44.445(d), so that the cross-reference now cites AS 17.30.200(n), formerly designated AS 17.30.200(o).
