Register 237, 12021 PROFESSIONAL REGULATIONS

Chapter 40. State Medical Board.

The emergency adoption of 12 AAC 40.430(r) is made permanent and that subsection is further amended to read:

(r) During an urgent situation as determined by the board, direct personal contact as required under this section may be met by audio and video [OR OTHER ELECTRONIC] means; "urgent situation" has the meaning given in 12 AAC 40.045. (Eff. 1/13/80, Register 73; am 7/11/81, Register 79; am 7/4/84, Register 90; am 3/12/89, Register 109; am 6/28/97, Register 142; am 3/27/2003, Register 165; am 9/1/2007, Register 183; am 5/8/2013, Register 206; am 12/8/2020, Register 237; am 3/26/2021, Register 237

Editor's note: Effective December 8, 2020, the State Medical Board adopted 12 AAC 40.430(r) as an emergency regulation, to appear in Register 237 (April 2021) of the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC).

The State Medical Board's action to make the regulation permanent also appeared in Register 237 (April 2021); as did a permanent amendment by the board to 12 AAC 40.430(r). Though the history note for 12 AAC 40.430(r) reflects the permanent amendment, the original emergency regulation alia not appear in print. The published version of the regulation displays the emergency regulation as amended.
