Chapter 56. Board of Marine Pilots.

12 AAC 56.028 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(j) An apprentice who has completed not less than 12 months of apprenticeship training 12 AAC 56.633 may make a request to receive credit for one year's experience under this section by submitting to the marine pilot coordinator documentation that demonstrates the trainee has completed 125 percent of supervised movements in (a)(1), (b)(1), or (c)(1) of this section. The marine pilot coordinator shall forward the request and documentation to the board. The board may grant credit equal to one year's experience to the trainee for the region for which the trainee has requested the request may pertain to credit. A trainee may not request experience credit more than one time and for only one region specified in this section.
