The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities after the close of the public comment period. To reduce financial hardship resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, the regulations delay by one year rents and permit fees at rural airports, except for the Deadhorse airport, where further increases are delayed until 2024. See, 17 AAC 45.127(c)(5).

The January 28, 2021 public notice and the March 15, 2021 adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.
