Stellar Marine Electronic Speed Pilot Engineering Services and Support

Introduction:

Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), Alaska Marine Highways (AMHS) is requesting information from vendors capable of working on Stellar Marine ESP 1000 speed Pilot Power Management System. The contractor will be needed to provide remote satellite monitoring and unlimited technical support service via telephone / or other means of communication. One annual post lay-up maintenance and inspection service will be needed at the end of the overhaul period for each vessel, and for any necessary software upgrades. The contractor will assist in fuel management reporting and data analysis as requested by the department.

The purpose of this Request for Information (RFI) is to identify potential vendors that can meet the specifications and functionalities described.

Background Information:

ESP 100 Propulsion Management Systems is deployed on six (6) vessels of Alaska Marine Highway Systems (AMHS). This system is for operating and cost efficiencies such as reduction and monitoring fuel usage, as well as real time tracking of vessels, allowing for AMHS and its numerous partnerships and vendors to closely coordinate down to the minute of scheduling of fleet operation. This system for years was installed and managed by Stellar Marine.
