GEOGRAPHICALLY DIVERSE INTERNET SERVICE PEER

Introduction:

The Alaska Permanent Fund Corporation (APFC) needs a geographically diverse Internet service peer to allow multihomed IPv4 and IPv6 advertisements for APFC netblocks.

Background Information:

Service providers should meet all of the following criteria:

- Service must be geographically diverse, between the APFC Point of Presence (PoP) at "801 W. 10TH ST., Juneau, Alaska 99801" to outside Alaska, from the current State of Alaska Core Telecommunications Data Network provider, Alaska Communication Systems (ACS)
- Service must provide BGP peering for APFC anonymous system numbers as well as multihomed IPv4 and IPv6 netblocks
- Service should have fiberoptic connectivity to APFC Point of Presence
- Service needs to be 1 gigabit synchronous
