- 1. This information is being provided to answer questions asked during the site visit.**
- 2. Questions and Answer for Lot 1.**

OMS Lot Snow Removal

Question: Can we stack in the back of the OMS yard?

Answer: No. All snow needs to be pushed out of the OMS gate to the dump area at the SE corner of the Armory Property.

Question: Are all open spots in the OMS yard to be plowed?

Answer: Yes. All open areas need to be plowed.

Question: Can we obtain a key to the OMS yard so we don't have to wait until 7:30 a.m. to plow the OMS yard?

Answer: Due to security concerns, we cannot issue keys to the OMS gate. Plowing must be done after 7:30 a.m. unless other arrangements have been made.

Question: There is a hazardous waste trailer in the OMS yard with ramps. Will these ramps be marked so we don't risk hitting them?

Answer: Yes. The OMS staff will put cones out to mark the ramps.

Question: There is an area in the corner of the yard near the Armory with a fuel tank. Does that area need to be plowed?

Answer: That area is not big enough for a plow so it does not need to be plowed.

Question: Can we leave our equipment in the OMS yard so it is secure?

Answer: Yes.

Armory Snow Removal

Question: Where do we put the snow from the ramp on the North side of the Armory?

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Answer: The ramp snow can either be hand shoveled and stacked on both side of the ramp or moved to the snow dump area on the SE corner of the property.

Question: How close can we stack to the light pole on the SE corner dump area?

Answer: Snow cannot be stacked closer than six (6) feet from the light pole.

Question: Do we need to shovel between the large concrete bollards in front of the Armory?

Answer: No. That is not a part of the contract.

3. Question and Answer for Lot 2.

Question: In the OMS yard, how far on the exterior of the fence do we need to cut grass?

Answer: Two (2) feet on the exterior of the fence. The city does the rest.

4. Mandatory Return Amendment. This amendment is a mandatory return amendment and does need to be signed and returned with your quote for it to be considered responsive.
