INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE 2022 SPORT FISH BUSINESS OWNER/GUIDE REGISTRATION

<u>Attention</u>: *The following will apply without exception*:

- 1. All applicable sections of the registration must be complete and legible prior to ADF&G validation. No "pending," "unknowns," or blanks will be accepted.
- 2. Incomplete registration forms will be returned, resulting in a processing delay.
- 3. A signature is required.

4. This is a temporary registration that expires in 21 days. Your wallet-sized registration card(s) will be emailed

to you. You may reply to the email to request a hard copy, which will be mailed to you within 2 business days.

5. There may be additional state and federal requirements to operate as a business or guide. It is your responsibility to determine what those requirements are.

INSTRUCTIONS:

SECTION A: <u>ALL</u> applicants must complete this section.

SECTION B: BUSINESS OWNER OR THEIR AGENT: Complete this section if you are the owner/agent of the sport fishing business. This section should be filled out even if the owner does not intend to personally guide clients. An agent for this business **CANNOT** apply as a guide on the same registration. A separate registration application must be submitted.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO BUSINESS OWNERS

State regulation (5 AAC 75.075) requires all business owners providing sport fishing guide services in Alaska to register with the Department of Fish and Game <u>before</u> guiding services begin. All business owners are required to register all charter vessels with ADF&G prior to commencement of guiding activities. Saltwater operators are also required to acquire logbook(s) before staring guiding operations. *Guides must have a copy of the business owner's ADF&G business registration in their possession while guiding.*

SECTION C: GUIDES: Complete this section if you intend to guide for a sport fish operation owned by someone other than you, or if you are a business owner who also intends to guide (owner/operator).

U.S. COAST GUARD OPERATOR'S LICENSE: A registered sport fish guide operating a motorized vessel with clients or transporting clients in a motorized vessel on navigable waters must have a USCG operator's license in their possession. If you are not sure of the particular USCG operator's license you need, you can contact USCG at (907) 271-6736 (option 5). To check on navigable waters, call USCG at (907) 428-4200 (option 4 – Prevention) then (option 5 – Waterways).

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO GUIDES

State regulation (5 AAC 75.075) requires all guides providing sport fishing guide services in Alaska to register with the Department of Fish and Game *before* guiding activities begin.

WHAT A GUIDE MUST HAVE IN POSSESSION WHILE GUIDING

A sport fish business owner or guide should be able to present all documents required for registration upon request by a representative of the Department of Fish and Game, peace officer of the state, or law enforcement representative of the National Marine Fisheries Service. While engaged in sport fishing guide services, a sport fishing guide shall have the following readily available for inspection.

- A current sport fishing guide registration;
- A copy of the current ADF&G sport fishing business registration of the guide's employer;
- A current Alaska sport fishing license and applicable tags, stamps or permits that are required to engage in the sport fishery for which the guide services are being provided;
- An identification card issued to the sport fishing guide by a state or federal agency that bears a photo of the sport fishing guide
- If operating in saltwater, a current years' logbook (paper or electronic)
