RFP #2022-2000-5006 - Electronic Monitoring Equipment and Services
RFP Due Date: **11/24/2021 @ 2:00 PM AST**

The purpose of this amendment is to address and answer the questions (Q&A's) submitted and other changes or additions to the RFP.

- 1) Can the State explain the difference between the contracted daily rate and the additional monitoring services as listed on Questions 6 and 7?

ANSWER: The contracted daily rate is the equipment rental rate, and the monitoring is for the rate for monitoring services for each piece of equipment (24/7 monitoring services for violations).

- 2) Does the additional monitoring include the local staff support services or something else?

ANSWER: The additional monitoring is the cost per piece of equipment for the monitoring service.

- 3) Lost devices: Does the State or the participant reimburse the vendor any equipment that is not returned for any reason?

ANSWER: It is generally the State, but at times, the participant will pay for the equipment.

- 4) Shelf Fees: Does the State pay the vendor any fees for shelf in excess of 10%? If so, how much?

ANSWER: We don't currently pay for excess. I'm not aware that we exceed the 10% due to our high turnover.

- 5) DV Victim App: As this is a new program segment, is there an estimate of how many people would use the App?

ANSWER: This is something new. We do not currently use a DV victim app. Approximately 30-40% of our Pretrial participants are DV (roughly 800-1000).

- 6) Please confirm that the information required by Section 4.02 (Proposal Introduction) does not count towards the 100-page limit.

ANSWER: Yes, it is. Anything that is required by the RFP and is to be provided in your proposal is part of the 100 Page Limit.

- 7) Please confirm that the summary of company policies required by Section 5.04 does not count towards the 100-page limit.

ANSWER: Yes, it is. Anything that is required by the RFP and is to be provided in your proposal is part of the 100 Page Limit.

- 8) Please confirm that resumes required by Section 5.04 do not count towards the 100-page limit.

ANSWER: Yes, it is. Anything that is required by the RFP and is to be provided in your proposal is part of the 100 Page Limit.

- 9) Please confirm that the three contracts (requirement clarified by Question # 58 in Amendment #2) do not count towards the 100-page limit.

ANSWER: Yes, it is. Anything that is required by the RFP and is to be provided in your proposal is part of the 100 Page Limit.

- 10) In regards, to Amendment 2, question #58, in providing contracts , grants, and/or subcontractors. The follow questions were asked.

Do we actually need to provide the whole contract?

ANSWER: No, please provide a list of 3 contracts similar in size and scope. Provide for each a summary of the scope of work (with as much details as possible), the total dollar value, length of the contract, approximate number of participants, name of contractor and location.

NOTE: The evaluation committee may contact the offeror if additional questions need to be addressed, which may hold up the evaluation process.

Please note that the **Cost Proposal Form** is still being worked on and will be issued soon.

The **proposal deadline date** has been extended to **December 8, 2021 at 2PM.**
