APF is seeking funds through the Recreational Trails Grant Program to create a safety and education video for new users to access Chugach State Park multi-use trails in the Anchorage area. The video will feature safety, trail etiquette and details about multi-use trails. The video will advertise the Glen Alps video webcam so users can see when the parking lot is too full, and find another trailhead to begin their adventure.
