Corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC):

Instructions to publisher for amendments to 7 AAC 145,

Department of Law project

In accordance with my authority under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. These revisions correct manifest errors in how laws were referenced in lead-in lines to the publisher, for Department of Health and Social Services regulations clarifying the conditions under which a tribal clinic that enrolls as a federally qualified health center (FQHC) and that receives Medicaid reimbursements may continue to offer identified covered services outside the clinic's fixed, brick-and-mortar site. The regulations were filed September 27, 2021 with an effective date of November 1, 2021 (Register 240 (January 2022) (Department of Law project file 2021200244).

The manifest errors in the relevant lead-in lines use the incorrect chapter number "7 AAC 140" for the addition of three new provisions. The correct chapter number is 7 AAC 145. Accordingly, for the three new provisions, the publisher should understand the lead-in lines to read: "7 AAC 145.700 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:"; "7 AAC 145.710 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:" and "7 AAC 145.720 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:"

Please note that an amendment to an existing provision, 7 AAC 145.700(a), already uses the correct lead-in line. That lead-in line does not require correction.
