Other Board Action/Issues/Discussion:

Miscellaneous Business:

1) Delegation to amend the Copper River King Salmon Management Plan re: escapement goal The Board approved a delegation to the department to adopt regulations to change the escapement goal language in 5 AAC 24.361 Copper River King Salmon Management Plan as provided for in RC118. The board indicated its preference that the department use the actual escapement goal numbers in the regulation. This delegation was assigned policy number 2021-302-FB.

2) Discussion on scheduling for Proposal 281 (ACR #7)

The board noted a request under PC14 asking the board to consider rescheduling Proposal 281 (formerly ACR#7) at some time other than the March Statewide Shellfish meeting given many stakeholders would be finishing in a Pacific cod fishery at that time. After discussion, the board considered individuals who would not be able to attend had adequate time to submit written public comments and could appoint others who could represent their interests at the March meeting. The board approved maintaining the existing schedule and keeping Proposal 281 at the March Statewide meeting.

3) Draft policy on abstentions during voting

After hearing two abstention votes at the Prince William Sound meeting, the board considered a draft policy on abstentions (RC119). After discussion, the board chose not to establish the policy.

4) General discussion on policies

The board had a wide-ranging conversation about board process. Much of the discussion revolved around processes on how to get ADF&G staff comments much earlier than currently provided, determining a way to handle hatchery proposals intended to reduce production capacity in such a way to minimize workload for the board, staff, and general public, and handling identical serial proposals that are submitted meeting after meeting without any new information.

5) Discussion on the development of a board-generated proposal on a subsistence guide definition In revisiting its action under Proposal 7, the board contemplated whether it made sense to generate a proposal intended to develop a statewide definition for subsistence fishery guide services. The board asked the department to draft language and present that to the board at the Southeast Finfish and Shellfish meeting for consideration and potential action.

The meeting adjourned at 9:57am on December 6, 2021.
