This delegation includes authority to amend other regulations as necessary to acknowledge or otherwise conform to the regulations that specifically provide for the logbooks or comparable records.

This delegation of authority supercedes the previous delegation (board finding #98-178A-FB).

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations concern reporting requirements for sport fishing services and sport fishing guides and adopt by reference the 2022 Saltwater Charter Logbook and Vessel Registration and the 2022 Freshwater Sport Fish Guide Logbook and Vessel Registration, an update from the 2021 editions of those same publications.

We find no legal problems. This memorandum constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The public notice and the adoption order state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.195 is not required.
