SCOPE OF WORK: BASIC BID

Contractor shall provide all necessary materials, equipment, and labor to construct and install the following (Reference Attachment A):

Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB) Category I Road

Quintin Circle: 629' +/- from CL Potbelly Stove Road to center of cul-de-sac; construct turnaround.

KPB Category III Roads

Potbelly Stove Road (North of Tehama Ave): 1551' +/- from CL Tehama Ave to center of Temporary Turnaround; construct turnaround.

Potbelly Stove Road (South of Tehama Ave): 2340' +/- from CL Tehama Ave to center of Temporary Turnaround; construct turnaround.

SCOPE OF WORK: ADDITIVE ALTERNATE #1

Contractor shall provide all necessary materials, equipment, and labor to construct and install the following (Reference Attachment A):
