Question 1: Is it permissible to dispose of clearing debris in the disposal area provided by the Contract docs?

Answer: No, the disposal area is for unsuitable soils only. Clearing debris may be burned, mulched, or removed from site.

Conditional Land Use Permits

Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB) does not consider new development in ADL 231493 (Cohoe Loop Rd material site) on the east side of the road to be a part of the Prior Existing Use. Thus the applicant would need to seek out a KPB Conditional Land Use Permit if they opt to develop the eastern side.
