**This amendment is issued to provide Q & A's.**

**Q** - Can you specify what facilities are ACA accredited and what facilities are NCCHC accredited?

**A** - We are not ACA or NCCHC accredited but strive to meet the NCCHC standards.

**Q** - Is your Healthcare contracted out? Medical, Behavioral Health (MH and SUD)?

**A** - The department has many healthcare contracts for different services but we do have in house medical staff as well.

**Q** - What percent of the overall DOC budget is for healthcare?

**A** - Unknown at this time.

**Q** - The RFP checklist asks for a "Litigation and Investigation History Statement" but there is no other mention of this statement elsewhere in the RFP. Will this statement be needed? What information would be needed in this statement?

**A** - Please remove or strike through this line on the Checklist. Not required.

**Q** - Section 3.03 of the RFP says, "The length of the contract will be from the date of award, approximately April 25, 2022. to June 30, 2022, with optional renewal up to February 23, 2023, at the sole discretion of the State." What work is expected to be completed by June 30, 2022?

**A – Yes, the state will be issuing the contract for the period of April 2022 through Feb 2023.**

**Q - Can you confirm that the State intends for the scope of work on this project to take place through February 23, 2023?**

**A – Yes.**

**Q - Would the extension from June 30, 2022, through February 23, 2023, be on a month-to-month basis?**

**A – No.**

**Q - Are there any optional renewals after February 23, 2023?**

**A – No not at this time but the state can do a month to month if needed at the states discretion.**
