Responses to Questions Received by Offerors

Question 1: The top coat for the moisture cure urethanes. Multiple suppliers said the micaceous iron oxide at the amounts specified prevent them from being able to tint the product to Yellow. One supplier said they can't do it and the other is waffling and hasn't came back with a solid answer. In light of industrial coatings experiencing shortages still, going with a base product insures availability. A two part polyurethane would be an upgrade. for the top coat.

Answer: The intent of the gate finish is to be feasibly corrosion resistant as well as reasonably visible. The gate specification has provisions for attached high visibility signage. The paint visibility of the gate (yellow paint) on the plans is subservient to the finish in the addendum specification. The DOF will base shop drawing approval of the gate finish primarily on compliance to the specified finish in Section 708-2.01.

Question 2: The spec provided specified a particular color from Fed Spec Std 595-B and it was grey. Which safety yellow did you want to specify, 13591 or 13655?

Answer: Pigment color FSS FED-STD-595B is acceptable.
