**The following are vendor questions and the department's response:**

1. Vendor: Requesting a one week extension on the response period for RFP-22-VSW-VAR-002, extending the due date from April 25<sup>th</sup> to May 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Given the scope and breath of the SOW, there is quite a bit of information and effort that goes into the proposal, and the original three week period is not quite sufficient to provide VSW a quality response.

Department: The RFP due date is extended from April 25, 2022 to May 2, 2022 @ 2:00 PM AST.

2. Vendor: In Part B, on Page 1, the RFP indicates to refer to the page limit in Part D. However, in Part D no page limit is indicated. What is the desired page limit for this proposal, if any?

Department: The RFP does not specify a proposal page limit. The State discourages overly lengthy and costly proposals.

3. Vendor: Section C.13 Price Proposal - is a price proposal required? If so, what is the basis (specific scope of work) for that price proposal? I understand the weight is zero points, but I'm seeking to confirm if a price proposal is or isn't a submittal requirement. Usually see this section crossed out or marked NA if it isn't required.

Section C.12 Labor Rates. Similar question. Are labor rates a submittal requirement?

Department: Per RFP Part B, #6 the box is checked for "price is not an evaluation criterion for the proposed contract". Same section states "Offerors identified in the Intent to Negotiate letter shall prepare Billing Rates and/or Price Proposals as described in Criteria #12 and/or #13."
