#### Questions submitted by potential offerors and answers from the state:

**Question 1:** Section 3.09 limits work performed by subcontractors to 20%. Section 4.01 states that offerors must submit separate proposals for IT consolidation services and for OPPM consolidation services if proposing on both service needs. Please clarify if this limitation applies to each individual service or to the total of work performed.

Answer: Subcontractors may be used to perform up to 20% of the work under the contract for each service.

Question 2: In order to propose our most qualified resources to the State we respectfully request increasing the limitation of work performed by subcontractors to 50%, in line with federal acquisition regulations for services (FAR 52.219-14, 13 CFR § 125.6).

<u>Answer</u>: Federal statutes do not pertain to this requirement. The State has determined that 20% is reasonable limitation on subcontracting.
