## Introduction:

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), Alaska Marine Highway System (AMHS) is requesting information from vendors capable of providing contractual assistance in the following areas:

- 1. Providing and installing dedicated and isolated, stand-alone wi-fi service with internet connectivity via satellite, to personal devices of Alaska Marine Highway (AMHS) crew, up to 60 crew members, on vessels while at sea and in port with wi-fi available on crew quarter and mess decks.
- 2. Provide, install, and configure, a stand-alone wi-fi delivery system for passengers aboard AMHS vessels with the option to monetize or restrict internet access, with methods to deliver catered hosted entertainment media or other content, similar to Alaska Airlines GoGo Inflight services.
- 3. Provide stand-alone and isolated public Wi-Fi services at AMHS terminals.

## **Background Information:**

The AMHS desires to provide crew members with wireless connectivity to internet for messaging and social media and general connectivity at sea while off-duty.

The AMHS desires to provide passengers with wireless connectivity to internet as well as access to streaming media for entertainment and or informational purposes.

The AMHS desires a provider whose service area covers a majority of the Alaska Marine Highway routes spanning from Bellingham, Washington to the Alaskan Southeast Panhandle, Cross-Gulf including Prince William Sound, and the Aleutian Chain.

## **Required Tasks and Deliverables:**

- 1. Install hardware for sufficient and consistent satellite connectivity and bandwidth on up to 10 AMHS Vessels
- 2. Install Wi-Fi access points, network wiring, and related hardware to provide broad accessibility aboard up to 10 AMHS Vessels.

## **Required Minimum Qualifications:**

Individual or firm must have experience deploying and or providing public Wi-Fi in a commercial or government transit setting.
