#### Questions submitted by potential offerors and answers from the state:

**Question 1:** The Amendment (Amendment One) states that the Kiosks need to have 21 inch screens minimum.

Our Kiosks are ADA compliant but are built with 17 inch screens. Does that disqualify our Kiosks

even though they are ADA compliant?

Answer: No, that will not disqualify your kiosk. As long as the screen is ADA compliant, the screen size may

be less than 21-inches. The state's preferred size is a 21-inch kiosk, but an offeror may quote screens

which are smaller than 21-inches as long as they are ADA compliant.

Question 2: The existing solution has the DMV branches, but also had a Vital Records department added to the

solution recently. There is no mention of that department in the current RFP scope. Will the Vital Records department be added to the new solution? Once the existing contract runs out in March,

Vital Records will lose access.

<u>Answer:</u> The Vital Statistics location is not a DMV requirement and is not part of this RFP.

Question 3: Responses are due next Thursday, is there any way to extend that date? That is a tight deadline

given there are so many uncertainties remaining for this RFP.

Answer: The deadline for receipt of proposals has been extended to Tuesday, November 8, 2022, at 2:00 PM

AKST.

**Question 4:** Offerors must also provide letters of reference for similar projects the offeror's firm has completed.

Are these to be provided by our Clients? If so, this requirement is going to take an unknown amount of time because we would be at the mercy of the clients on this one. How many references do we

need? Are these to be written by clients?

<u>Answer:</u> Yes, the letter(s) of reference must be written by a client. At least one letter of reference must be

included with your proposal.
