Question 1.

what happens in the case the supplier runs out of sand because they only crushed so much for the year and the bid is put out late will it fall back on the contractor?

Answer 1.

It is the Department intent for the Contractor to provide sufficient sand quantities to meet contract requirements. In the event that a contractor can't supply sufficient sand volumes the contractor will be required to provide justification why such volumes cannot be supplied and what additional options have been taken in an effort to provide the needed volumes. The department will reviewed this justification and if determined sufficient will in cooperation with the contractor look to alternate options for sand to include but not limited to other known supplier stockpiles, adjusting sand gradations, and or as a last result provide sand to the contractor. Any such changes will be done through contract change order to include any price adjustments.

Question 2.

For deliverable 1 when snow accumulation reaches 2 inches we are to start plowing that is understood but how long after the 2 inch depth is reached do we haft to show up 12hrs?

Answer 2.

For deliverable #1 Plowing Services. The contractor shall commence snow control plowing when snow depths reach 2". Please see ITB Attachment #5 Performance targets including response times further clarification of service delivery requirements.
