Changes to the ITB:

<u>Change 1:</u> Add the following to Sec 2.01, "The dates for actual work will be determined by aircraft usage, and the contractor must be available within one week of a request for scheduling. DPS will provide regular updates to the contractor of engine time so estimated work dates can be identified as the project deadline approaches."

<u>Change 2:</u> Add the following to Sec 2.09, "Remaining time on serialized parts, whether new or used, are to be documented on a FAA 8130 of equivalent return to service document. Parts will only be accepted where the life limits are equal or greater than the rest of the components already in the engine."

<u>Change 3:</u> Remove the second sentence of Sec 2.11 to read, "The contractor will prepay the shipping and delivery charges to and from 4825 Aircraft Drive, Anchorage, AK 99502."

Change 4: Add Sec 2.21 Components, Parts, and Tools

- a. All parts removed or installed in the aircraft will be coordinated with the DPS Stock and Parts using appropriate reporting to ensure serviceable status, accountability and inventory control.
- b. Title to State-furnished property will remain with DPS. The Contractor shall maintain adequate property control records in accordance with industry standards to ensure that State parts are not utilized for other purposes.
- c. All parts removed may be required by the Aircraft Section to be returned to the DPS Aircraft Section and shall be identified serviceable/unserviceable with the appropriate tag with the required information listed prior to the project being completed.
- d. The state shall have first right of refusal on all salvage parts that come from Department of Public Safety aircraft.
