QUESTIONS SUBMITTED BY OFFERORS AND ANSWER FROM THE STATE

Question 1: I spoke to DNR a while back so now they want all assets out of there????

Answer 1: Yes, all watercrafts bellow the high tide line and listed in the RFQ are to be impound and disposed. The other fiberglass boat that is in the same cove, beached above the mean high

tide line, is not a part of this RFQ.

Question 2: Do we know for sure there are people living there?????

<u>Answer 2</u>: The extent to which someone is living on the vessel is currently unknown. The Department

of Natural Resources posted notice on the vessel on November 18, 2022, at that time no one was onboard the vessel. However, is it suspected that this vessel is occupied at times. The Department of Natural Resources is actively working to make contact with the suspected occupant and can provide additional information regarding the vessel's occupancy as it

becomes known.
