Questions submitted by potential offerors and answers from the state:

Question 1: Will the State be filling in the recessed portion of the video wall to make room for a larger video wall?

Answer: This will be dependent upon the proposal selected by the Proposal Evaluation Committee.

Question 2: If the State does not fill in the recessed portion of the video wall, is it acceptable for the contractor to fill in the recessed portion of the video wall?

Answer: No. The contractor may not fill in the recessed portion of the video wall. If the Proposal Evaluation Committee selects an offeror whose proposal is based on the need to have the recessed portion of the video wall filled in, the department will work with their Facilities Management Office to perform the work.

Question 3: Would the current format of the video wall, 4 columns and 2 rows, be acceptable if larger displays, 55” displays instead of 46”, were installed?

Answer: No. This would not solve the complaint of not having visual continuity. Section 3.01 states, “offered replacements should be frameless, providing visual continuity with viewing excel spreadsheets, PowerPoint presentations, video conferencing, etc.”

Question 4: Do the executives sit on both side of the “top” seating?

Answer: There are three seats at the head of the table where the executives sit.
