(3) submits a completed, notarized application on a form provided by the

(A) applicant's name and license number;
(B) name and location of the applicant's dentistry practice facility or
business; and
(C) applicable fees required in 12 AAC 02.190.
(b) A dentist may only advertise as a specialist in a branch of dentistry that is recognized
by the board, including

(1) endodontics;

(2) oral and maxillofacial surgery;

(3) oral and maxillofacial radiology;

(5) orthodontics and dentofacial orthopedics;
(6) pediatric dentistry;
(7) periodontics;
