SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska  
Administrative Code (AAC):  
4 AAC 06.079

In accordance with my authority under AS 44.62.125(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. These revisions correct manifest printing errors.

The regulation to be revised is 4 AAC 06.079. The revisions to that subsection are as follows:

- In the introductory language of 4 AAC 06.079(b)(1), please delete the phrase: “with a grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a scale of 4.0”.

- Please set out 4 AAC 06.079(b)(1)(A) to read: “achieve a grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a scale of 4.0 in English language arts classes;” and re-letter the subsequent subparagraphs accordingly.

- In 4 AAC 06.079(d)(3) please change the word “freshman” to “sophomore”.

In addition, in the editor's note following 4 AAC 06.079 please add a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:

As of Register 245 (April 2023), the regulations attorney made corrections under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), to 4 AAC 06.079 to reflect adopted changes not previously incorporated.
