In accordance with my authority under AS 44.62.25(b), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. This revision corrects typographical errors in the April 2023 Supplement, Register 245.

The regulations to be revised are located in 12 AAC 36. The revisions to the regulations of that chapter are as follows:

- Please correct the language of 12 AAC 36.112(b)(5) to read “verification of a current license or registration” from “verification of a current registration”.
- Please correct the introductory language of 12 AAC 36.112(c) to read “shall issue a temporary military courtesy certificate of registration” from “shall issue a temporary certificate of registration”.
- Please correct the language of 12 AAC 36.112(c)(1)(A)(iv) to read “licensure or registration in another” from “registration in another”.
- Please correct the language of 12 AAC 36.112(c)(2)(A)(iv) to read “licensure or registration in another” from “registration in another”.
- Please correct the language of 12 AAC 36.112(c)(3)(A)(iv) to read “licensure or registration in another licensing or registering jurisdiction” from “registration in another licensing jurisdiction”.
- Please correct the language of 12 AAC 36.112(c)(4)(A)(iv) to read “licensure or registration in another” from “registration in another”.

- Please add an editor's note following 12 AAC 36.112 to read as follows:

As of Register 245 (April 2023), the regulations attorney made technical corrections under AS 44.62.125(b)(6) to 12 AAC 36.112(b)(5), 12 AAC 36.112(c), and 12 AAC 36 112(c)(1), (2), (3), and (4).
