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1.0 Introduction / Summary

1.1 Purpose

This document provides a high-level description of the relationship between WinSTAR and the interfaces used. This Interface Control Document defines type of interface, the partner WinSTAR is interfacing with, and the purpose of the interface.

1.2 Scope

This Interface Management Plan details procedures that comprise the analysis, conversion, and testing of all interfaces pertaining to WinSTAR. The key elements in the Interface Management Plan include:

- An overview of the current state of WinSTAR interfaces
- A description of the development process for creating new interfaces
- A description of the procedures used to test the interface functionality for accuracy and completeness



2.0 Overview

2.1 Outgoing Interfaces

A file is created from WinSTAR and placed into a known location. The file is then transferred, typically by VisualCron, from the specified location to the file exchange location for the external partner or the mainframe server for it to be transferred to OCSE.

2.2 Incoming Interfaces

A file is typically deposited by the external partner, and polling or event-driven mechanism triggers notification of the receipt of data, which is then automatically picked up, moved to the WinSTAR server, and processed by the relevant Natural program(s).

3.1.3 Function Allocation

WinSTAR: WinSTAR is the start that creates the outgoing file or end point that consumes the incoming file for each interface.

VisualCron: VisualCron is the job manager outside of WinSTAR. VisualCron transfers files to and from most servers internally as well as provides the FTP connection to external partners.

Cyberfusion: Cyberfusion is only component that still resides on the mainframe server. Cyberfusion is used to transfer files to and from the Office of Child Support Enforcement.

3.1.4 Interface Requirements

File transfer must be done securely, most often done via SFTP using both a username and password as well as key pairs.



4.0 Roles and Responsibilities

The following table describes the roles and responsibilities with regard testing of the WinSTAR system's interfaces with external partner systems.

5.0 Interface Management

The process of accurately converting all interface batch jobs and the technical and database components on which they are dependent must be managed in a systematic and controlled manner and relies on the cooperation and collaboration of many groups. The following steps define our high level approach towards managing this portion of the WINSTAR project:

Phase	Step	
Analysis	1	Identify interface requirements, transfer details including schedule and frequency, and timeline.
Development	2	Meet with partner agencies to discuss the development and testing plans for their respective interfaces, agree on partner responsibilities and time frames for collaborative testing

Testing	4	Perform Unit Testing to determine if connection will meet requirements, is functional, and secure.
	5	With the assistance of the partner agency / entity, perform System Integration Testing.
	6	Perform User Acceptance Testing to confirm accuracy

Maintenance	8	Systems monitors interface and maintains security of the connection.

5.1 Interface Testing

5.1.1 Unit Testing

Unit testing is done to establish the connection and is generally a part of the development process. Unit testing is accomplished in accordance with the iterative development process. Since testing an interface relies on an external input, Unit Testers use mocked up files in place of actual files from the partner agency/entity's system. These files use precisely the same file layout as that of the interface partner and accommodate multiple scenarios for a comprehensive test.

Before moving to the next phase, System Integration Testing, the interface components must demonstrate a successful completion of Unit Testing as proof that all functions produce the expected results.

5.1.2 System Integration Testing

System Integration Testing consists of comprehensive set of scenarios that include regression and negative tests. Unlike Unit Testing, interface components that are promoted to the System Integration Testing phase undergo a two-stage approach aimed at ensuring that the desired functionality remains intact.

The first stage involves the creation of mocked up files for use in initiating the interface's batch processing and fully executing and documenting all scenarios as identified in the test script. After the successful completion of this initial stage and once the interface component's functionality has been confirmed as correct Systems then proceeds to coordinate with the interface partner



to execute the second stage of System Integration Testing. In this second stage, the interface partner coordinates the transmission of a test file to WinSTAR environment. These files are then used by the Systems team to again execute all applicable scenarios from the test scripts created by the Systems team.

5.1.3 User Acceptance Testing

The Research and Development team will then State will have the opportunity to perform its own testing of converted interface components as part of the User Acceptance Testing phase. The State is responsible for creating its own test scripts and coordinating with the interface partners in the transmission of files. Protech will provide any support needed including workstation configuration support, technical support, and/or the provision of testing script templates. The UAT Test Plan provides full details on how to plan and perform the testing.
