SUBJECT: Corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC): 5 AAC 09.365

In accordance with my authority under AS 44.62.125(b)(6), please forward to the publisher the corrections to the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) described below. These revisions correct a technical error in a regulations project filed May 23, 2023, and set to be published in the July register.

In a recently transmitted regulations packet (File No. 2022200305), we noticed a technical omission in an amendment to 5 AAC 09.365(d). The new paragraph added by that amendment should read:

"(3) for drift gillnet gear, beginning June 10, commercial fishing periods will begin at 6:00 a.m. and run 88 hours until 10:00 p.m. three days later; commercial fishing will then close for 32 hours and reopen at 6:00 a.m. two days later; the final commercial fishing period will end at 10:00 p.m. on June 28."

Please use this language when implementing the amendments to 5 AAC 09.365 for this project. Thank you for your assistance, and please contact me if you have additional questions.
