The purpose of this public comment is to give an opportunity for all Alaskans and those in the transportation and construction industries a chance to give feedback on this goal methodology.

As a recipient of FHWA funding the State of Alaska and the Civil Rights Office are required to submit a DBE goal methodology triennially. This goal methodology has been prepared according to the criteria set forth in [49 CFR Part 26.45](#), and it is based on demonstrable evidence of the availability of all DBE firms that are ready, willing, and able to perform work on FHWA-assisted contracts relative to all businesses that are ready, willing and able to participate on FHWA-assisted contracts.

For FFY 2024-2026, DOT&PF has established an overall **DBE goal of 9.39%** to be accomplished entirely through the use of race-neutral means.
