- Modify sections of this RFP

Questions and Answers:

The following are the state's responses to questions that have been submitted in response to RFP 2523H011.

Question 1:

Section 3.14 of RFP 2523H011 states that all work must be completed in the US and there is no provision for a waiver. The earlier grant IRFP and the currently open Functional Class RFP both include language that allows for waiving the US work location requirement under certain conditions.

See RFP 2523H081 Statewide Functional Classification Update - Federally Funded, Section 3.07: "If the offeror cannot certify that all work will be performed in the United States, the offeror must contact the procurement officer in writing to request a waiver at least 10 days prior to the deadline for receipt of proposals. The request must include a detailed description of the portion of work that will be performed outside the United States, where, by whom, and the reason the waiver is necessary."

Would DOT&PT consider amending RFP 2523H011 to include the location waiver language above previously used by DOT&PF in IRFPs and RFPs?

Modifications to RFP Section Language:

1. RFP section 3.14 Location of Work, has been removed in its entirety and replaced with the following language.

SEC. 3.14 Location of Work

The location(s) the work is to be performed, completed and managed the contractor's place of business

The State will not provide workspace for the contractor. The contractor must provide its own workspace.

The contractor shall include in their price proposal: transportation, lodging, and per diem costs sufficient to pay for 2 person(s) to make 2 roundtrip(s) to Juneau, AK. Travel to other locations will not be required.

By signature on their proposal, the offeror certifies that all services provided under this contract by the contractor and all subcontractors shall be performed in the United States.

If the offeror cannot certify that all work will be performed in the United States, the offeror must contact the procurement officer in writing to request a waiver at least 10 days prior to the deadline for receipt of proposals.

The request must include a detailed description of the portion of work that will be performed outside the United States, where, by whom, and the reason the waiver is necessary.

Failure to comply with these requirements may cause the state to reject the proposal as non-responsive, or cancel the contract.
