RE: ADDENDUM NO. 01 TO REQUEST
FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) PACKAGE:

HFHWY00285 & HFHWY00286; Bridge and Tunnel Management Term Agreement

The RFP Package is hereby clarified or changed as follows:

1. The proposal due date remains unchanged.
2. Proposers Questions and Answers:

Q1: Please note that the RFP makes reference to the "Small Procurement Standards Provisions Booklet" as the document containing the standard T&Cs. The Booklet states that the included T&Cs are for procurements between \$10k and up to or equaling \$200k. However, the RFQ states the estimated amount of proposed contact is between \$500k and \$1 million.

A1: The RFP is a formal solicitation between \$500,000 - \$1 million. Further on in the RFP document it states: "The General Conditions are the same for both Competitive Sealed Proposals and Small Procurements."

Q2: Is the intent that the DOT will issue individual Task Orders for only between \$10k and \$200k, and those Task Orders are considered eligible for Small Procurements? OR, should there be a different set of T&Cs/Agreement used for larger procurements?

A2: Correct, task orders can range from \$10,000 - \$250,000. Since this is being conducted as a formal solicitation to award a term agreement, task orders are not considered small or large, they are simply task orders under a formal/large agreement.

Q3: Appendix C, Compensation, does appear to allow for Cost Reimbursement Contracts >\$250k, thus creating additional confusion.

A3: This is a formal “large” agreement.

Q4: Does the DOT want brief bios for key staff in lieu of resumes and if so does that count toward the eight page limit?

A4: Correct, please include brief bios in your proposal package, it will count towards the 8-page limit.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
