**Modifications to ITB Sections**

1. ITB Section 3.01 Scope of work & Deliverables is removed in its entirety and replaced with the following.

**Section 3.01 Scope of work & Deliverable**

The Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is seeking proposals from qualified training providers to deliver Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF) training to DOT&PF Maintenance and Operations (M&O) personnel in the State of Alaska. The purpose of this RFP is to identify a vendor that can deliver comprehensive, and FAA Certified ARFF training to enhance the capabilities and preparedness of DOT&PF M&O personnel in responding to aircraft-related emergencies. The selected vendor shall provide the following services and deliverables:

Task A. The contractor will develop ARFF training curriculum that includes advanced (40 hours) Basic (40 Hours) Hot Drills (10 hours) and the specific needs of DOT&PF M&O personnel.

Task B. The contractor will deliver classroom-based instruction covering topics such as aircraft familiarization, fire behavior, firefighting tactics, rescue techniques, hazard mitigation, and emergency response procedures.

Task C. The contractor will conduct practical, hands-on training sessions to reinforce theoretical knowledge, including live-fire training exercises utilizing appropriate safety protocols.

Task D. The contractor will train the M&O personnel on the proper operation and maintenance of ARFF equipment, including fire suppression systems, extinguishers, hoses, and vehicles.

Task E. The contractor will provide comprehensive training materials, including manuals, reference guides, ARFF instructor, classroom for instruction, SCBA's including backpacks and air bottles compatible with DOT&PF Masks and a FAA approved ARFF training facility in the State of Alaska capable of live fire training.

The State will reimburse the contractor for live fire fuel costs at actuals based on the submission of receipts for the fuel included with invoices submitted for services rendered under this contract. The State will provide SCBA's masks for the firefighter training.

Task F. The contractor will evaluate and assess the training effectiveness through practical assessments and knowledge-based tests.

**Task G. The contractor will provide lunch and drinks for each student for each training conducted.**
