## Questions submitted by potential offerors and answers from the state:

**Question 1:** Is there known lodging provided for the contractors for this project?

**Answer:** We have had contractors stay at The City Rooms, but I have no other recommendations or knowledge of lodging in the area. Contacting the City of Elim is recommended for the most up to date lodging information.

**Question 2:** Can you confirm that the 13 bore holes would have two analytical samples for each DRO? And only one to two samples will require a full analysis for Diesel Range Organics (DRO), (Residual Range Organics (RRO), Gasoline Range Organics (GRO), lead, Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC), and Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons (PAH)?

**Answer:** Samples should be taken during every 5 feet bags interval. The average depth to refusal was about 9 Ft. It can be expected that 2 samples should suffice for each borehole, but more may be required. 2 samples with the full suite should be representative for the for the purpose of this contract.

**Question 3:** What is the purpose of the transportation, lodging, and per diem costs for 2-4 persons to make one trip to Elim, Alaska.

**Answer:** This is the recommended amount of logistics planning. If the contractor feels that people are needed, they should budget accordingly. Travel and lodging costs will be paid as part of the larger contract and not through reimbursement.
