The following questions are here presented and answered:

Question 1. I notice under “SEC. 6.02 ALASKA BUSINESS LICENSE AND OTHER REQUIRED LICENSES”. It says “Prior to the award of a contract, an offeror must hold a valid Alaska business license. However, in order to receive the Alaska Bidder Preference and other related preferences, such as the Alaska Veteran Preference and Alaska Offeror Preference, an offeror must hold a valid Alaska business license prior to the deadline for receipt of proposals.” But then later in this paragraph, it says “You are not required to hold a valid Alaska business license at the time proposals are opened if you possess one of the following licenses and are offering services or supplies under that specific line of business:”. And lists different licenses. Do we need a license of any sort before applying?

Answer 1. This depends upon offeror intention.

- The referenced Section 6.02, Alaska Business License and Other Required Licenses, offers an opportunity to utilize a different type of license instead of a business license, if offeror is “offering services or supplies under that specific line of business.” Because this RFP seeks services other than those listed for the alternative licenses, then offeror must have an Alaska business license, which must be current at time of award.
- However, if offeror chooses to claim any of the Alaska preferences cited in said section, then Alaska business license must be current and active prior to the deadline for receipt of proposals.

Question 2. Can you confirm that the only in-person requirement for this RFP is a one-time trip to the annual Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC) PQC Grantee meeting?

Answer 2. Yes, the only in-person requirement is the annual Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC) PQC Grantee meeting.
