See below for questions submitted by potential offerors and answers from the state:

Question 1: RFP Section 1.04 has required each proposer to have a "licensed CPA eligible to practice in Alaska" on their team. However, RFP Attachment #2 Cost proposal form doesn't include a job class for a CPA. What is AKDOT&PF's expectation on how the offerors should include a CPA's rate when there is not a predefined job class for a CPA? Or does AKDOT&PF not want the offerors to include the CPA's rate at all due to the fact that AKDOT&PF has already predefined the job classes in Attachment #2 and has chosen to not include a CPA job class?

Answer: The licensed CPA eligible to practice in Alaska is an administrative requirement for the proposer. It is not a predefined job class for the cost proposal form.
