This amendment serves to answer the following questions:

- Q. Will oversize/overweight haul units be allowed for the transport of E1 from the barge landing to the designated stockpile area?
 - A. Yes, with a CMV permit, all state and federal laws must be followed. See [MS/CVC Commercial Vehicle Customer Service Center \(alaska.gov\)](#) for additional information.
- Q. Will a representative from ADOT be onsite to verify the CYVM counts? Or will the contractor be providing these as material is delivered?
 - A. No, Alaska DOT will not have staffing available without significant advanced notice.
- Q. Would ADOT accept a survey of the stockpile once complete in lieu of CYVM?
 - A. Yes, additionally Alaska DOT will be surveying the stockpile for confirmation.
- Q. Would ADOT consider barge displacement or scale tickets from the source in tons as measurement for payment?
 - A. No, Alaska DOT will not consider averaging weight through barge displacement. Yes, scale tickets will be accepted, additionally Alaska DOT will be surveying the stockpile for confirmation.
