Questions submitted by interested vendors:

Question 1: In the meeting on February 8, 2024, Alaska DPS stated that there were only 4 workstations. In the RFP Amendment One, answer to question #5 stated DPS has 100 workstations. Does Alaska DPS want us to propose replacing all 100 workstations, or can we utilize existing workstations? If utilizing existing workstations, do you have the specifications of those workstations?

Answer:

DPS will need licensing for a minimum of 100 workstations, with role-based access to the proposed software solution. The number of workstations brought up during the initial meeting was representative of one unit's need but is not representative of DPS's overall need. DPS will be utilizing the existing workstations. DPS is looking for either a software solution that can be installed on existing workstations or web-based application(s) that can be installed on a server and accessed via the workstations. Specifications of the workstations can be supplied during discovery.

Question 2: In question #12 [of the previous amendment] it was stated that the chosen vendor should be prepared to provide 50 scanners and application licenses. Does Alaska DPS already have scanners and if so what scanners do they currently have?

Answer:

The proposal should include the vendor-recommended scanner model. Costs for the recommended scanner model shall be provided as a separate line item under Non-Evaluated Costs. The RFP 2024-1200-0130 Cost Proposal - Updated must be used, and this line MUST be responded to in order to be considered responsive.

Changes to the RFP:

Change 1: The deadline for proposals is extended to March 15, 2024 at 4:30pm prevailing Alaska Time.

Change 2: Because DPS does not state a preference of the type of hosting for the system, all hosting fees shall be listed as a separate line item under Non-Evaluated Costs. Hosting fees shall not be included with the offeror's evaluated costs. The RFP 2024-1200-0130 Cost Proposal - Updated must be used, and this line MUST be responded to in order to be considered responsive.
