GRADES K-3 SUMMER TUTORING

Introduction:

Alyeska Reading Institute is working to provide summer school grants to provide K-3 students with targeted interventions who have a reading deficiency.

Background and Project Information:

Alaska Reads' Act (<u>link to more information</u>) was implemented on July 1, 2023. It requires districts to provide 20 hours of targeted interventions in the summer for third grade students who have a reading deficiency. The state of Alaska is seeking information for those who can:

- provide tutors and programs/materials (Must align with the Science of Reading)
- Or provide instructional coaches to support schools with interventions that aligns with the Science of Reading

These services consist of, but not limited to: Tutors:

- Provide virtual tutors who can provide 20 hours of targeted instruction in a one to two-week period
- Provide intervention materials for the targeted instruction
- Provide resources for parents to support reading at home
- Create a positive working relationship with parents and the school
- Provide the tutoring through Zoom
- Progress monitor

Instructional Coaching:

- Provide a virtual coaching model to support teachers provided by the school/district
- Provide virtual professional development
- Provide intervention materials for the targeted instruction
- Provide resources for parents to support reading at home

Minimum Experience Required for Tutors:

- Must hold a valid teacher's certificate
- Successfully completed a course that supports the Science of Reading
 - Examples: Keys to Literacy, LETRS
- Has a minimum of 2 years' experience teaching in a virtual setting

Interested parties are invited to submit responses to the following:

- 1. Submit a comprehensive narrative statement that would focus on the services listed for tutors and/or instructional coaches
- 2. Provide documentation to confirm how all parties, including tutors, meet the minimum requirements.
- 3. Submit a narrative centered around professional development that could be provided
- 4. Include any infographics or promotional materials that explain relevant services
- 5. Submit pricing options
