Important Note to Bidders: **Bidders are required to acknowledge receipt of this addendum on the Bid Form.** It is the bidder's responsibility to review and accept all addenda to this solicitation. If you do not acknowledge receipt of this addendum your Bid Form may be considered non-responsive. This addendum is being issued to recognize changes and/or answer questions to the Invitation to Bid (ITB). Only the ITB terms and conditions referenced in this addendum are being changed. All other terms and conditions of the ITB remain the same. Corrections to the ITB.

This addendum forms a part of the contract documents and modifies the original drawings and/or specifications for the subject work. In case of conflicts between this addendum and previously issued documents, this addendum shall take precedence.

The following changes are required:

1. The response requirement for the **Deadline for Receipt of Bids** has been extended to April 10, 2024, at 2:00 pm Alaska time.
2. The Bid Bond (Form 25D-14) requirement has been removed from this solicitation. No Bid Bond is required.
3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS Section 1.06 WORK SEQUENCE AND MILESTONES, B. is changed to read: "All work shall be substantially complete by June 30, 2024."
4. The asphalt overlay will be 2" of type 2A asphalt.
5. A seventh Additive Alternative was added, the locations for each was changed, and Attachment A has been updated to reflect these changes.
6. An updated Bid Schedule (DMVA Form 30-06), reflecting the seven Additive Alternatives is attached and

replaces the existing.

7. An updated Alaska Bidder Preference Certification (Form 25D-19) and Alaska Veteran Preference Certification (25D-17) are attached and replace the existing forms. The state logo is the only change to these forms.

Questions submitted by potential offerors and answers from the state:

Question 1: During the walk through, everything that was expressed sounded like you wanted to remove all the asphalt in that section and put down 4-5 inches of asphalt?

Answer 1: Removal of asphalt is not anticipated. An overlay of 2" of type 2A asphalt is the expectation.

Question 2: Seems as though the original scope of work is changing so just to clarify, you want damaged asphalt removed and new asphalt put down and material then taken off site?

Answer 2: Removal of asphalt is not included in the solicitation. If asphalt is removed the disposal location will need to be approved by the project manager.

Question 3: Is this project a federal funded project?

Answer 3: This is a state funded project.

Question 4: Are the wages to be paid to laborers supposed to go off the Pamphlet 600 labor rate?

Answer 4: Yes, State wage rates are to be paid; use the State wage rates that are in effect 10 days before Bid Opening.

Question 5: Being that school is open, work being performed, will there need to be a safety plan in place? Flaggers in place?

Answer 5: The current class graduates on June 13th. The next class begins on July 16th, 2024. Flaggers are not needed for the Academic Avenue repaving as it isn't a thoroughfare.

Question 6: Are we going to be able to stage equipment on site?

Answer 6: Staging area will be available upon coordination with the project manager.
