(a) A claimant <u>who is</u> required to register for work under AS 23.20 and 8 AAC 85.351 <u>shall</u> [MUST] actively seek suitable work by <u>performing</u> [MAKING] at least one valid work search <u>activity</u> during each week that the claimant files for unemployment insurance benefits.

(b) The division may require a claimant to <u>perform</u> [MAKE] more than one valid work search <u>activity</u> during a week that the claimant files for unemployment insurance benefits based on <u>the population and labor market of</u> [EACH OCCUPATION SUITABLE FOR THE CLAIMANT WITHIN] the area in which the claimant <u>resides while</u> [IS] filing <u>a benefits claim</u> [BENEFIT CLAIMS]. <u>For each benefit week in which the claimant files a benefits claim, the</u> [THE] division will <u>provide the</u> [NOTIFY A] claimant [OF THE CLAIMANT'S] <u>with the</u> <u>number of work search activities that the claimant is required to perform,</u> [WORK SEARCH REQUIREMENT FOR A GIVEN BENEFIT WEEK BY] using a method specified <u>under (c) of this section</u> by the director.

(B) visits a job center for a reemployment service or career workshop, attends a job interview, or performs a similar high-engagement activity approved by the director; and

(2) [(3)] the work is suitable [UNDER 8 AAC 85.410] to the claimant's skills and abilities under 8 AAC 85.410 [CAPABILITIES; AND
