Exclusive Economic Zone operators not landing in Alaska must submit completed fish tickets to Computer Services, Division of Commercial Fisheries at ADF&G headquarters in Juneau.

DEFINITIONS AND CODES

DATE CAUGHT:

The date of permit holder's first harvest for this delivery.

DATE LANDED:

FOR A CATCHER VESSEL –

The date the catch off-load is completed to a land-based processor or floating processor.

FOR A CATCHER PROCESSOR –

The last date the product is caught and brought on board for the fish ticket.

FOR A CATCHER SELLER VESSEL –

The date the product is initially brought into port.

STATISTICAL AREA:

The five-digit statistical area(s) where harvest occurred. Please refer to the appropriate ADF&G salmon statistical area chart. If catch occurred in more than one statistical area, indicate the percentage of harvest from each statistical area.

**PARTIAL DELIVERY
(SPLIT TICKET):**

If a portion of the harvest from the fishing trip was documented on another fish ticket or delivered to another processor(s), then note the other processor's name and the associated salmon fish ticket number in the box provided on the fish ticket. The fish ticket number begins with the letter "A" followed by 8 numbers and is located in the upper right-hand corner of the ticket.

DUAL PERMIT:

Dual permit information is required on the fish ticket when two permit holders jointly operate gear while both are present on the same vessel. Check the dual permit box and on the first line write in the CFEC permit information including all 10 figures as they appear on the card (ex: S03N99999X). On the second line, write in the information that appears on the last line of your permit card, which includes the two digit year, two-digit sequence number and alpha check figure (ex: 1301X).

**ITEMIZING YOUR CATCH ON THE
FISH TICKET:**

Harvest must be itemized and recorded individually for each species by delivery condition code. If salmon roe is extracted before sale, that roe must also be included on a fish ticket in addition to the carcasses. If the roe is intended for the bait market, handwrite "bait" on the line for that item.

DELIVERY CONDITION CODE (DELIV. CODE):

A code utilized by ADF&G that describes the condition of the fish at the time it is delivered or recorded on the fish ticket. Common codes utilized for salmon are listed below. See ADF&G code sheets for additional codes.

Whole	01
Gutted, head-on	04
Headed and Gutted	07
Roe only	14
Carcass, Roe-removed (for female only)	25*
Personal use (no sale)	95

* 25 Code used for female carcass where roe has been removed but guts/viscera remain.

PRICE:

The amount paid per pound of fish for a line item (species by delivery condition code).

AMOUNT:

The pounds of fish multiplied by the price per pound for a particular species by delivery condition code.
