They also provided a network wireless connection to AKANG buildings for the Automated Logic Energy Management and Control Systems. At the time of award Meridian Systems was the only assigned distributor for Automatic Logic within the State of Alaska and has exclusive rights to sell, service and warranty on all installed Automatic Logic products. The 176th s HVAC system is monitored and operated by the Automated Logic Energy Management and Controls System (EMCS).
