Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Marijuana Control Board against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Marijuana Control Board after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations repeal the requirements that an applicant for a marijuana retail store license or marijuana product manufacturing facility license submit a copy of an active application for a food safety permit with Department of Environmental Conservation or a delegated municipality before the application for the marijuana retail store license or marijuana product manufacturing facility license can be considered ready for board review by a licensing examiner.

The March 13, 2024 public notice and the April 23, 2024 certification of adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

No technical corrections were necessary to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060.
